STANDARDS FOR SUMMER CAMP

Camp Jacob is a special place that is set aside for God's ministering. The Bible gives many examples in which God blessed humans because of their efforts to maintain holiness. It is our desire for God to bless and perform a mighty work in the lives of those who come to Camp Jacob. Therefore, we have adopted certain standards in an effort to maintain holiness at our camp. Here is a summary of these standards:

1. There is to be no use or possession of alcoholic beverages or illegal drugs.
2. There is to be no smoking or any other use of tobacco.
3. Ungodly printed materials are prohibited.
4. Secular music is not permitted unless specifically approved by the Camp Director.
5. There is to be no mixed swimming or members of the opposite gender at the swimming area during a gender specific swim time. Exceptions are permitted for children under the age of 8 who wish to swim with their parent or guardian of the opposite gender.
6. No personal contact in the form of flirtatious or sexual advances except between a husband and his wife is permitted.
7. Shorts above the knee, tight clothing (including yoga pants), tank tops with straps less than three finger widths, or immodest clothing are prohibited in public company of both genders.
8. No shirts imprinted with beer, wine, liquor or other ungodly advertisements are to be worn.
9. Ladies and girls: Knee-length dresses or skirts must be worn for evening services. Slits may not be higher than required hemline. One-piece swimsuits (no bikinis) must be worn for swimming.
10. Men and boys: Shirts with collars and pants (no shorts) must be worn for evening services. Shirts must be worn when in mixed groups. Regular shorts (no bikini shorts) must be worn for swimming.
11. During the weeks of camp, electronic entertainment devices are prohibited except as used in worship by personnel. However, cell phones will be allowed for Youth Collision camps during our new "Home Connect" times. They will be locked up and checked in and out to use.

OTHER GENERAL RULES

Camp Jacob has adopted the following rules for the general well-being of the camp's property and for maintaining safety of the campers. These rules must be followed unless granted specific permission from the Camp Director.

1. No camper is to be in another cabin, in the kitchen, in the wastewater treatment facility, in the barn, or at the lake without the specific permission or direct supervision of a counselor or adult leader.
2. Male campers are not to be at the girl's cabins, and female campers are not to be at the boy's cabins.
3. Campers should be in the general area of their group unless given specific permission by a counselor or adult leader.
4. Shoes are to be worn at all times when outside of the cabins except when swimming, bathing, or given specific permission by a counselor or adult leader.
5. Snacks are to be kept in the designated areas and, with the exception of water, may not be taken on the hill or to the lake area.
6. Campers should not bring or possess any type of weapon.
7. Practical jokes and pranks that could harm another individual, another individual's property, or camp property are prohibited.
8. Campers are not allowed to use the phone without specific permission from the Camp Director.
9. Camp property and equipment is only to be used as designed.
